- I. **6:31 pm, President, Jenn Hunt** Welcomed everyone, made a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting. Aline Crompton and Cynthia Pittenger approved the minutes.
- II. **Treasurer, Lisa Ducote** Lisa went over the treasure report. Aline Crompton and Theresa Hall approved the Treasurer Report.
- III. **Teacher Update, Perry White** – Pigs will be clipped on Saturday, January 11th at 9:00am, first come first serve. We don't have clippers to loan out like we do for the lambs and goats so we will do all the pigs that day. For the lambs and goats, you will need to check out the clippers. Kelly White has the book and clippers. For TCYS, pen set up is Tuesday, January 14th. The website says to be there by 5:00pm but we usually start around 4:00pm. We can't get the kids out of class early. If you want to get your kid out of class early then that is fine. There will be a sign in and sign out sheet so make sure you sign in as soon as you get there. On Thursday, January 16th we all will meet at the barn at 5:00am. We will load the trailers and be on the road to TCYS by 6:00am. Check in starts at 7:00am. For the lamb and goat people, your animal has to have a muzzle on for the trailer and at TCYS. For a list of what you need to bring to TCYS, please see our website. I will bring the hanging feeder racks so you just need to bring your feeder and clips.
- IV. **Vice President**, **Melyssa Abernathy** For pen decorating night, please bring gloves and wire cutters. If you think you might need a step ladder then you can bring one of those too. We don't need all the parents there so around 15 parents will be sufficient.
- V. **President, Jenn** The jeep raffle tickets are due today. Every family should have sold at least 25 tickets. At the end of this meeting, we will have stations. Come to me at the jeep station and I will mark you off. You can write one check for everything or just give me the money for the jeep raffle tickets. Then you will just move down the line to the cantina. You can sign up for the cantina and volunteer to help work it. It is \$50 per person unless you're under 10 years old. Then go to the trailer station to make sure you have paid for your trailer spot. We will prepay for the shavings tonight. There will be a station for the shaving too. Pigs will need to purchase 3 bags of shavings, 1 for trailer and 2 for pen at TCYS. Lambs and goats will need to purchase 2 bags, 1 for trailer and 1 for pen at TCYS. Steers will need 4-5 bags of shavings. We will be

voting for the board members for next year at our March meeting so please let us know if you would like to volunteer. Aline Crompton will be leading the scholarship committee. She needs 3 more people on the committee. We will be taking \$15,000-\$20,000 to TCYS. We have reserved 28 trailer spots at TCYS. There is an updated buyers list on our website. Send out your buyers letters to the buyers in a timely manner. For the cantina, I want to thank Jane Ellen, Bud, Kendall, Steve and Sunny for taking on the cantina. They have been working very hard on the menu for approx. 70 people.

VI. Jane Ellen Carter – I want to thank Katie Graykowski for making all the desserts for the cantina. I have a list of everyone who has signed up for the cantina. If you haven't signed up and would like to then please let me know. We are gathering a list of items that we might need help with so we might be sending out a text. Everyone will need to bring chairs to sit on. There will also be a firepit. For Thursday, lunch will be from 11:00am-1:00pm and dinner will be from 5:00pm-7:00pm. For Friday and Saturday, breakfast will be from 7:00am-9:00am, lunch 11:00am-1:00pm and dinner 5:00pm-7:00pm. On Sunday, breakfast is from 7:00am-9:00am. We will need a couple volunteers for Saturday for breakfast and lunch because our kids will be showing. We will also have snacks and drinks out for the day. We do need some people to bring some firewood. We will have wristbands for everyone that paid for the cantina.
