Logistics

ONE WEEK PRIOR TO SHOW ~ ALL STEERS WILL BE CLIPPED (limited # of clippers. Check with teacher)

Tuesday, January 14 @ 4 PM to Barn Set-up @ Expo Center

Wednesday 4 PM to 8 PM: Decorate LT Pens for Herdsmanship

Thursday 5:30 AM: Arrive to load all steers on trailers at LT barn for transport to TCYS

Thursday 7:00 AM – 10:00 AM: Steers arrive & weigh

Thursday to Friday ~ AM&PM – Feed according to schedule (8:00 AM & 5:00 PM) or as needed.

Saturday AM: Feed and water animal as scheduled. Plan accordingly to wash/groom steer.

Saturday 6:00 PM: Market Steer Show

Sunday 6 AM: Meet at Expo Center to load steer on trailer and transport back to LT barn.

All Steers must be washed with iodine shampoo before going back into the barn.

Recommended Supplies

- Pen shavings (must be purchased from TCYS but pre-collected by Alumni)
- feed bucket
- Wire-ties and/or baling wire
- Food for each feeding (4 days)
- Equipment to wash on-site (hose, bucket, shampoo, etc.)
- Halter/lead rope
- Show Halter
- Show Stick
- Towel
- Fungus spray (optional)
- brushes
- Poop rake and bucket
- Dress nicely for show ring (boots and button shirt?)
- Dress appropriately for the show (no pajamas, school dress code++). Show LT Pride!!!
- Folding chairs, jackets, gloves, hats etc. (often it's cold and rainy)
