~Meeting called to order at 6:00PM by Holly Noak

President Holly Noak opened the meeting and reminded everyone to sign in.

Aline Crompton asked to speak and was told she could after last meeting minutes were reviewed.

Secretary, Jessica Walker called a motion to pass minutes from the previous meeting, Aline Crompton made motion and Shelly Judd seconded. All in favor, none against, Minutes approved.

Aline Crompton addressed the group to give an update on rabbits. Currently the breeder has no rabbits for our group, Aline has called out to multiple other breeders and is hopeful we can find some.

President Holly Noak shared that sponsorship is at \$20,153, goal is \$25,000. 56% of membership dues have been paid. Fall fundraiser goal is \$10,000, we are currently at \$8962.78. Pet Shot made \$42400, P Terry Spirit Night made \$292, Hoco extravaganza made \$155 and Cav Classic made \$4131.98.
